- from June 20 to July 20 (full-time education),
- from 20 June to 13 October (extramural studies)

Documents for admission:

- statement;
- a document proving the identity and citizenship;
- the original of the document of education or its photocopy;
- two photographs of 3x4 (matte, identical);
- other documents may be provided to applicants if they are applying for benefits established by the legislation of the Russian Federation;
- the application for admission may also be accompanied by documents, the provision of which meets the interests of the applicants themselves (certificates, certificates);
- A copy of the certificate of marriage (or change of name).
